

Bandit 1890 chipper now with 213hp

Over the years Bandit's popular 19" capacity Model 1890 "Brute" chipper has earned a great reputation with Australian users - and now it is even better. Bandit's engineers have re-designed it so that it now come standard with a whopping 213hp CAT diesel engine. Nothing beats horsepower when you want to chip our hard Australian hardwoods and this CAT C6.6 diesel engine is rated at 213hp and an enormous 932 Nm of torque!

Bandit Tree Equipment Sales Manager, Jeremy Gosper, tells us how he feels about the changes. "That 932 Nm torque number is what really impresses me. This is over 50% more torque than our main competitor has on their 19" chipper. With 213hp the Brute's performance is something very special. It has to be seen to be believed."

The 1890 Brute was designed from the ground up to offer the most performance in a compact, single axle design. Fitted with an over-sized 5,500kg capacity axle the Brute still weighs in at under 4,500kg so that it can still be towed by a relatively small truck. The chipper is fitted with electric brakes and it should not need to have annual pit inspections for rego renewals. Air brakes are available as an option.

The Bandit 1890 Brute is fitted with a very heavy duty chipper drum, and the chipper shaft is supported by 2 15/16" pillow block bearings. Behind it's two horizontal feed rollers the infeed opening is huge; 26" high x 20.5" wide, and the chipper drum is positioned very close to the feed rollers so that the Brute cuts and processes difficult, forked timbers without hang ups. This machine comes standard with the monster 213hp CAT engine, hydraulic lift and crush for the top feed roller, Auto-Feed Plus system to control the infeed, a powerful hydraulic winch, and a hydraulically powered discharge chute swivel - all features that are designed with performance and operator safety in mind.
